INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 83—Lee (Coauthor: Kalra). An act to amend Section 85320 of, and to add Section 82007.5 to, the Government Code, relating to the Political Reform Act of 1974.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 84—Ward. An act to amend Sections 214 and 259.15 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 85—Akilah Weber. An act to add Section 1367.37 to, and to add Article 4 (commencing with Section 127380) to Chapter 2 of Part 2 of Division 107 of, the Health and Safety Code, to add Section 10123.52 to the Insurance Code, and to add Section 14132.14 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to health.
