**CONSIDERATION OF SENATE AMENDMENTS BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT**

Assembly Member Evans was granted unanimous consent to suspend Assembly Rule 77 to permit consideration of Senate amendments to Assembly Bill No. 2, without reference to file.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2 (Evans)**—An act to add Sections 6051.9, 6201.9, 6357.6, 7374, 17044, 19136.8, and 60709 to, to add Part 21 (commencing with Section 42001) to, to repeal Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 7360) of Part 2 of, and to repeal Part 31 (commencing with Section 60001) of, Division 2 of, the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.
