INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 72—Bates. An act to amend Sections 8212 and 8226 of the Education Code, and to amend Sections 1596.859 and 1596.890 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to child care.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 73—Lowenthal. An act to add Section 4003 to the Financial Code, relating to unsolicited checks.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 74—Mountjoy. An act to amend Sections 2800.1, 2800.2, 2800.3, and 40000.7 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 75—Negrete McLeod. An act to amend Sections 20835, 21460, and 21625 of, and to add Section 21626.5 to, the Government Code, relating to public employees’ death benefits.
