**PRAYER**

Upon invitation of Speaker pro Tempore Lowenthal, the following prayer was offered by Reverend Bob Oshita:

In 1945, Albert Einstein and Robert Oppenheimer were among the Atomic Scientists that created the Doomsday Clock. Using the image of the apocalypse being midnight, the Doomsday Clock conveys how close we are to nuclear annihilation.

During the Cuban Missile Crisis in October of 1962, it was moved from 12 minutes to midnight to just 7 minutes.

This year, for the second year in a row, these respected scientists set the clock even closer to midnight than it has ever been before. The clock is now set at 85 seconds to midnight. 85 seconds . . .

In setting the clock, the Bulletin of Atomic Scientists, considered global tension and conflicts, international relations, the world economy and even emerging technology, climate change and global health.

However, the Clock is not a prediction of war. It is a warning. It is a symbolic call to action that was first created by those who conceived of, developed and witnessed the use of atomic weapons. It is a reminder that, left unchecked, humanity is heading towards global self-destruction.

I grew up having to practice atomic bomb drills in elementary school. Such drills are no longer done. We all now know that in the event of a nuclear war, huddling children where the walls are thickest and away from windows will not save them. In the event of all-out nuclear war, there will be no winners.

With our Wisdom Eyes open, we see what has always been true—we all share this one earth, and we must care for and learn to share this Wonderful World with one another.

Namo Amida Butsu—Let us try to live with kindness and gratitude beyond words.
