INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 31—Davis. An act to add and repeal Chapter 5.5 (commencing with Section 10410) to Part 7 of the Education Code, relating to pupil testing.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 32—Strom-Martin. An act to amend Sections 22112 and 22454 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 33—Torlakson. An act to add Section 17052 to the Education Code, relating to school facilities.
