INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 69—Washington. An act to amend Section 17052.15 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 70—Woods. An act to amend Sections 912.5 and 1736 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to juveniles, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO.71—Wright. An act to amend Section 94986 of, and to repeal Section 94990 of, the Education Code, and to repeal Section 32 of Chapter 62 of the Statutes of 1996, relating to postsecondary education, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 72—Knox. An act to add Article 7.5 (commencing with Section 12330) to Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to public social services, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
