ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 76—Miller. An act to amend Sections 1368 and 1375 of, and to add Sections 1363.1 and 1368.5 to, the Civil Code, relating to common interest developments.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 77—Morrow. An act to add Sections 17053.26 and 23626 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 78—Granlund. An act to amend Sections 12020, 12021, 12026.2, 12201, and 12322 of the Penal Code, relating to firearms.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 79—Granlund. An act to amend Section 1417.5 of, and to add Section 11108.5 to, the Penal Code, relating to criminal procedure.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 80—Ducheny. An act to amend Sections 17274 and 24436.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 81—Wright. An act to amend Section 23399 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
