Dear Mr. Ohnimus:

The following information is being filed with you in conformance with legislation enacted last December relative to legislative representation.

I am employed as legislative representative for the City and County of San Francisco under the terms of the contract issued annually by the Mayor and have been so employed since November 15, 1944. I receive a salary of \$12,000 per year which is paid monthly by warrant issued by the Controller of the City and County of San Francisco. My appointment was unanimously confirmed by the Board of Supervisors acting under a section of the general laws, codified during 1949 as Chapter 942 of the Government Code. Section 50023 of this code reads:

*50023. The legislative body of a local agency, directly or through a representative, may attend the Legislature and Congress, and any committees thereof, and present information to aid the passage of legislation which the legislative body deems beneficial to the local agency or to prevent the passage of legislation which the legislative body deems detrimental to the local agency. The cost and expense incident thereto are proper charges against the local agency.

In addition to the annual salary paid to me there is an amount of money appropriated by the Board of Supervisors to the account of the Mayor for costs and expenses. This is in the amount of \$15,000 and is for secretarial employment, office overhead, stationery, stamps, travel, hotel and conference expenses.

If any of the expenses fall within the provisions of chapter 4 he will voluntarily provide such information to the clerk of the assembly and the secretary of the senate although, as previously stated, it is not believed that he is within the provisions of chapter 4.
