At the meeting of the Council held March 1, 1950, the following resolution was adopted:

"Whereas, the Legislature of the State of California will convene in regular session at Sacramento on March 6, 1950, and the best interests of the City of Los Angeles require that this Council have authorized representatives in Sacramento during sessions of the Legislature as authorized by Section 50023 of the Government Code of this State;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Los Angeles, being the legislative body thereof, that Ray L. Chesebro, City Attorney, and Lewis E. Arnold, Engineer of Administration of said City, public officials of said City acting in their official capacity, be and they are hereby appointed and designated as the duly authorized representatives of the City of Los Angeles at Regular and Special Sessions of the Legislature of the State of California to attend the sessions of said Legislature and Committees thereof, and present information to aid the passage of legislation which the City Council deems beneficial to the City of Los Angeles or to prevent the passage of legislation which the City Council deems detrimental to said City, and to attend conferences and meetings in this State where necessary or desirable in the interest of such legislation. The cost and expense incident thereto shall be a proper charge against the funds of said City.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to draw demands upon the Council Fund, Item "Legislative Expense", to defray the expenses of said representatives or their designated deputy, upon their request, or the request of either of them, with the approval of the State, County and Federal Affairs Committee of this Council. They and their designated deputies are hereby authorized to use a City automobile for transportation when, in their opinion, it is desirable. Said representatives and their designated deputies shall furnish the Controller itemized statements accounting for all such expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said City Attorney be requested to assign William H. Neal, Senior Assistant City Attorney (Legislation), to perform the duties imposed upon him by this resolution."



Dear Mr. Ohnimus:


The following information is being filed with you in conformance with legislation enacted last December relative to legislative representation.

I am employed as legislative representative for the City and County of San Francisco under the terms of the contract issued annually by the Mayor and have been so employed since November 15, 1944. I receive a salary of \$12,000 per year which is paid monthly by warrant issued by the Controller of the City and County of San Francisco. My appointment was unanimously confirmed by the Board of Supervisors acting under a section of the general laws, codified during 1949 as Chapter 942 of the Government Code. Section 50023 of this code reads:

"50023. The legislative body of a local agency, directly or through a representative, may attend the Legislature and Congress, and any committees thereof, and present information to aid the passage of legislation which the legislative body deems beneficial to the local agency or to prevent the passage of legislation which the legislative body deems detrimental to the local agency. The cost and expense incident thereto are proper charges against the local agency."

In addition to the annual salary paid to me there is an amount of money appropriated by the Board of Supervisors to the account of the Mayor for costs and expenses. This is in the amount of \$15,000 and is for secretarial employment, office overhead, stationery, stamps, travel, hotel and conference expenses.

The following information is filed although it is not believed that Chapter 4, first extraordinary session of 1949 applies to Vincent O. Kennedy.

Vincent O. Kennedy is the managing director of the California Retailers Association, a trade association comprised of retailers throughout the State of California. He is in direct charge of all of the activities of this Association which encompass all matters relating to the common problems of the members. Any activity relative to legislative matters is only incidental to the general and year-round problems of the Association and its members, and no portion of the salary of the managing director is allocated to the period when he might be in Sacramento during the sessions of the California legislature or to any activities relative to legislation before that legislature. The managing director is paid a specified yearly salary which does not vary by reason of any problems incident to the sessions of the California legislature. His employment is of indefinite duration having no relationship to the California legislature. Mr. Kennedy receives from the association reimbursement for expenses he has incurred in the furtherance of his work as managing director of the association. If any of the expenses fall within the provisions of Chapter 4 he will voluntarily provide such information to the clerk of the Assembly and the secretary of the Senate although, as previously stated, it is not believed that he is within the provisions of Chapter 4.




