S.B. No. 2—Lockyer.

An act to add Section 7012.5 to the Penal Code, to amend Section 1 of Chapter 1549 of the Statutes of 1982, and to amend Section 10 of Chapter 532 of the Statutes of 1986, relating to prisons, and making an appropriation therefor.

Sept. 11—Introduced. Read first time. To Com. on RLS. for assignment to print. Art. IV, Sec. 8(b), of Constitution suspended. To Com. on JUD.

Sept. 12—From committee: Do pass as amended. (Ayes 8. Noes 3. Page 15.) Unanimous consent granted to consider without reference to file. Read second time. Amended. To third reading. Read third time. Passed. (Ayes 22. Noes 11. Page 14.) To Assembly

Sept. 12—In Assembly. Read first time. Held at Desk.

Sept. 16—Art. IV, Sec. 8(b), of Constitution suspended. Read second time. Amended. Read third time. Passed (Ayes 41. Noes 11. Page 28) To Senate.

Sept. 23—In Senate. To unfinished business. Senate refuses to concur in Assembly amendments. (Ayes 12. Noes 14. Page 21)

Nov. 30—Died on file.
