*There is in the Interest and Sinking Fund at this date, exclusive of the amount necessary to pay the out-standing bonds of 1857 and 1860, as also the interest on bonds due January 1, 1881, a surplus of \$97,316 67, which sum is applicable to the redemption of bonds, and which would, if so applied, result in an annual saving to the State of about \$6,000. After carefully examining existing laws, I concur in the opinion of my predecessor, as expressed in his report of 1879, that an Act by the Legislature is necessary, designating the particular series of bonds to be redeemed.
