REMARKS.—Bonds No 1 to 103 inclusive, of \$1,000 cach, of the series known as the funded dobt of 1873, were called in June 1, 1881.
As above shown, unnety-nine of such bends have, up to the thirtieth of June, 1882, been surrendered and paid, leaving four still outstanding, which however bear no interest, as interest on all the bonds called in ceased after September 1, 1873, causing thereby an annual saving to the State of \$6,189.
Outstanding bends of 1857 and 1860 have not been bearing interest since July 31, 1875.
