**28. Legislative Reapportionment. (Constitutional Amendment.)**

[Submitted by the initiative and approved by electors November 2, 1926 In effect  
December 15, 1926]

*A proposition to amend section six of article four of the Constitution of the State  
of California so as to read as follows:*

## ARTICLE IV.

SEC. 6. For the purpose of choosing members of the legislature, the state shall be divided into forty senatorial and eighty assembly districts to be called senatorial and assembly districts. Such districts shall be composed of contiguous territory, and assembly districts shall be as nearly equal in population as may be. Each senatorial district shall choose one senator and each assembly district shall choose one member of assembly. The senatorial districts shall be numbered from one to forty, inclusive, in numerical order, and the assembly districts shall be numbered from one to eighty in the same order, commencing at the northern boundary of the state and ending at the southern boundary thereof. In the formation of assembly districts no county, or city and county, shall be divided, unless it contains sufficient population within itself to form two or more districts, and in the formation of senatorial districts no county, or city and county, shall be divided, nor shall a part of any county, or of any city and county, be united with any other county, or city and county, in forming any assembly or senatorial district. The census taken under the direction of the congress of the United States in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and every ten years thereafter, shall be the basis of fixing and adjusting the legislative districts; and the legislature shall, at its first regular session following the adoption of this section and thereafter at the first regular session following each decennial federal census, adjust such districts, and reapportion the representation so as to preserve the assembly districts as nearly equal in population as may be; but in the formation of senatorial districts no county or city and county shall contain more than one senatorial district, and the counties of small population shall be grouped in districts of not to exceed three counties in any one senatorial district; *provided, however*, that should the legislature at the first regular session following the adoption of this section or at the first regular session following any decennial federal census fail to reapportion the assembly and senatorial districts, a reapportionment commission, which is hereby created, consisting of the Lieutenant Governor, who shall be chairman, and the Attorney General, Surveyor General, Secretary of State and State Superintendent of Public Instruction, shall forthwith apportion such districts in accordance with the provisions of this section and such apportionment of said districts shall be immediately effective the same as if the act of said reapportionment commission were an act of the legislature, subject, however, to the same provisions of referendum as apply to the acts of the legislature.

Each subsequent reapportionment shall carry out these provisions and shall be based upon the last preceding federal census. But in making such adjustments no persons who are not eligible to become citizens of the United States, under the naturalization laws, shall be counted as forming a part of the population of any district. Until such districting as herein provided for shall be made, senators and assemblymen shall be elected by the districts according to the apportionment now provided for by law.

\* Initiative and referendum measures adopted by the electors become effective five days after the declaration by the Secretary of State of the vote thereon, unless otherwise indicated in the measure. Constitutional amendments submitted by the legislature and approved by the electors become effective the date of approval by the electors, unless otherwise indicated in the amendment.
