WHEREAS on this date, pursuant to Section 10 (f) of Article IV of the Constitution of the state of California, I have proclaimed a fiscal emergency; and

WHEREAS on this date, I am submitting to the Legislature proposed legislation to address that fiscal emergency; and

WHEREAS this extraordinary occasion having arisen and now existing, it requires that the Legislature of the State of California be convened in extraordinary session.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARNOLD SCHWARZENEGGER, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me in accordance with Section 10(f) of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of California, do hereby convene the Legislature of the State of California to meet in extraordinary session at Sacramento, California on the 19th day of December 2008, at a time to be determined, to consider and act upon legislation to address the fiscal emergency proclaimed by me this day.

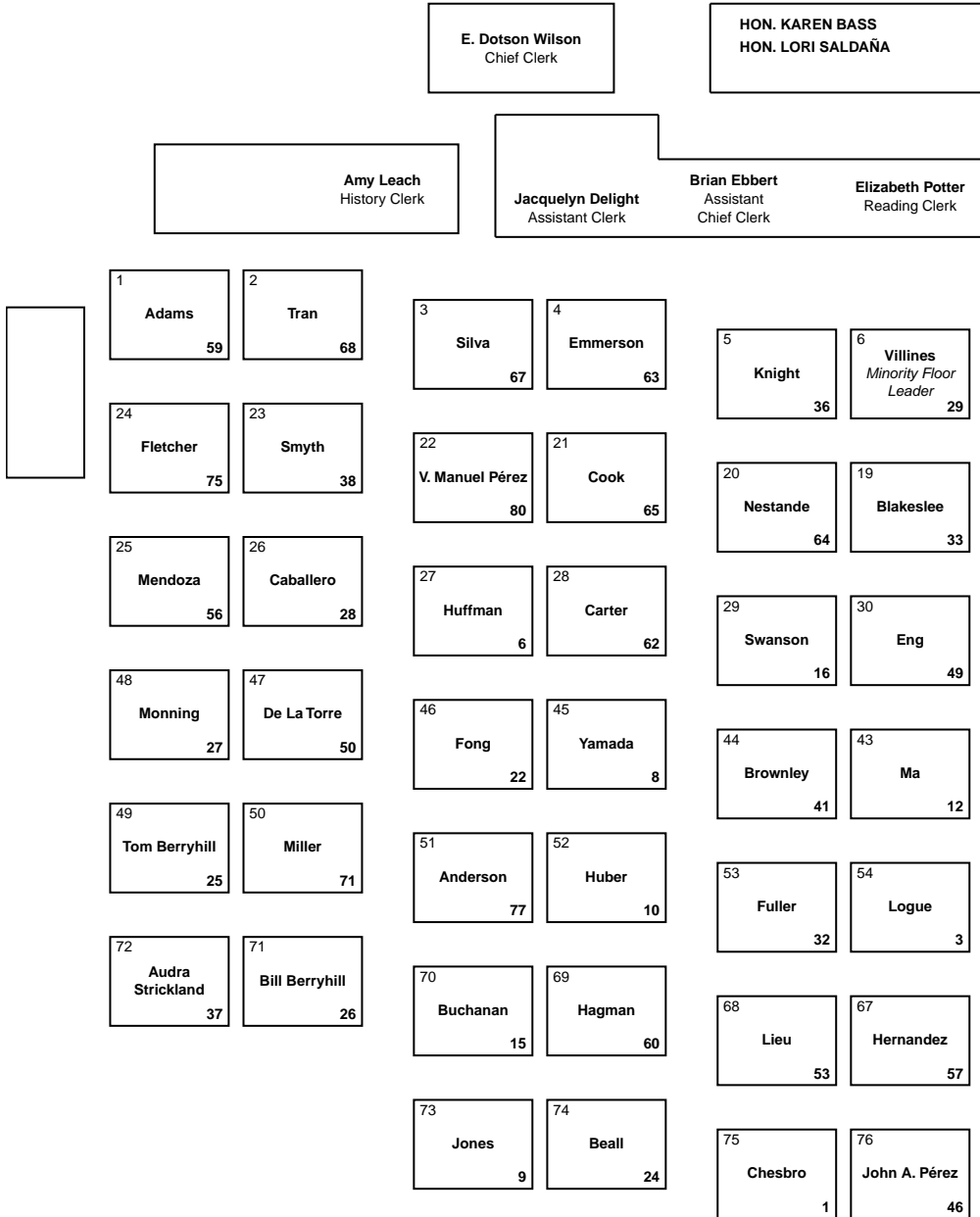
